BRIEF BIOGRAPHY

Vajra Ma is a priestess, educator, sacred dancer/performer, and a shamanic healer. She holds ministerial credentials through the Reformed Congregation of the Goddess and Circle of Aradia.

She has designed and facilitated women's ritual since 1986, and, in the process, has integrated Goddess knowledge and feminist spirituality with experiential body wisdom (the conscious awareness of subtle body energies) to forge *Woman Mysteries of the Ancient Future Sisterhood*, a modern mystery school and Priestess lineage. Her Red Door Priestess Arts Training is a comprehensive program preparing women for their individual ministry. Vajra Ma originated *The Tantric Dance of Feminine Power*, a unique feminine yoga and moving meditation, also known as The Yoga of Shakti.

Vajra Ma has been featured in *The Wall Street Journal*, *Newsweek* and *The Whole Life Times*. *She* developed her mastery of energetic work over two decades through dance studies of Continuum, Tantric Dance, Middle Eastern, Sufi, folk and ballet, 15 years healing work as a bodyworker and formal study of psychic and ritual skills. In addition to her BA and two years graduate work in Theatre Arts, she has an extensive professional background as actress, vocalist, director, and teacher. Vajra Ma coached Marisa Tomei for her acclaimed dance in the title role of *Salome* in Al Pacino's Broadway production (2003).

Vajra Ma is a compassionate and skillful guide for women and men, ready to unfold into their innate power. She resides in southern Oregon with her husband Wolfgang E. Nebmaier and their various dangerous pets.
